REPORTED OFFENSE: Armed Robbery, Felonious Assault

On Sunday, December 15, 2019, at approximately 7:00 pm a man walking on the sidewalk of 1401 E. Court St. in front of the Mott Library was the victim of an armed robbery and felonious assault. The suspect has not been apprehended at this time.

Suspect:

Suspect is described as a black male between 20 and 30 years of age, 6'2", full head of hair, no glasses, dark complexion, specifically stated that he was homeless, using an aluminum baseball bat as a weapon, wearing black gloves.
